The Hon'ble CEM, Karbi Anglong Autonomous Council, Diphu, Karbi Anglong (Assam).

Sub:- Prayer for adopting "The Assam Venture Educational Institution (Provincialisation of Services) Bill 2011" after modifying some of the provisions and prayer for solution of some grievances in respect of education under Karbi Anglong Autonomous Council.

Respected Sir,

The undersigned on behalf of the Bodo Sahitya Sabha have the honour to bring your kind attention to some provisions of THE ASSAM VENTURE EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS (PROVINCIALISATION OF SERVICES) BILL, 2011 and request your honor to modify some of the provisions which will affect the venture Schools and Colleges as well as Bodo Medium Education.

Section 3(1) (i):

That Sir, from 1996-2006 the then AGP Government had banned the permission and recognition of schools. But most of the Bodo Medium Schools are obtained permission and recognition from the Government after 2006. Therefore, in the case of Bodo Medium School, the base year to be extended upto 2008.

Section 3(1) (ii):

That sir, in clause 3(1)(ii) it is mentioned that there should be 25 enrolment in highest class i.e. class-V in L.P. School, Class-VIII in U.P. School, Class-X in High School, Class-XII in Jr. College or H.S.S. and Degree Final Year in Degree Colleges. But in case of tribal areas and Bodo Medium, there should be no such condition and enrolment bar.

Section 3(1) (iii):

The Academic performance should be reduced at least from 30 % to 10 % as because of backwardness of some areas and disturbances in case of tribal areas and Bodo Medium Education.

Section 3(3):

As the Right to Education Act. 2009 has been already introduced in the state, the Assam non-Government Educational Institutions (Regulation & Management) Act. 2006 to be scraped and as TE, the Government should take establishing new schools whenever necessary.

Section 4(1):

That Sir, in the matter of Educational Institution like venture school, the Act speak about the provincialisation of services and terms and conditions been imposed 10 years for their regularization by this act. But it may be mentioned here that the venture schools are continue by arranging new teacher time to time. In this way they have been compelled to fillup the gaps in time for smooth running the school.

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Therefore, we urge upon your honor to modify this provision and consider all the teachers approved by the appropriate authority till this date.

Section 5(3):

This Section seems to be injustice shown to the teachers who have rendered several years of service to the school and completed 60 years at the time on this date of coming into force of this act.

Therefore, we urge upon your honor to modify this clause and count the service period from the date of recognition and approval of the services by the appropriate authority and to provide them a good amount of remuneration on humanity ground.

Section 4(2) and 10(4):

We urge upon your honour to modify this Sections 4(2) and 10(4) and provide maximum number of employees per educational institution whose services shall be provincialised.

Degree College: As per clause maximum number of posts has been shown in total: 30 Nos.

But we would like to request your honor to increase upto 35 Nos instead of 30 posts including English & MILs.

Junior College: As per clause maximum number of posts has been shown 8 Nos.

We would like to request your honour to increase upto 16 instead of 8 Nos (2 posts for each subject including English & MILs).

Higher Secondary School: As per clause maximum number of posts has been shown 7 Nos.

We would like to request your honor to increase upto 10 Nos instead of 7 Nos(2 posts for each English & MILs).

High & High Madrassa School (2 Classes): As per clause only 1 Hindi teacher has been shown. But in case of mixed medium schools it should be 2 posts.

Therefore, we would like to request your honour to increase upto 12 Nos of posts instead of 10 Nos of posts including 1 more post for Hindi Subject and 1 more post for language teacher in case of mixed medium schools. Because, it is seem that in the Bodo Medium High Schools language teachers have been authority concerned in the time of recognition. Therefore, we urge upon your honor to provide language teacher for non Assamese Medium Schools.

Upper Primary Schools (M.E. School & M.E. Madrassa): As per clause maximum number of posts has been shown 9 in total. We would like to request your honour to increase upto 13 Nos instead of 9 posts.

Assistant Teacher: 2+2= 4 in case of mixed medium schools.

Graduate/Intermediate teacher Science & Mathematics should be 1 + 1 = 2 in case of mixed medium schools.

Hindi Teacher in rank of Assistant Teacher should be 1 + 1 = 2 in case of mixed medium schools.

Primary School (L.P. School): (i) Head Teaher-1, Assistant Teacher should be 2 + 2 = 5 in case of Mixed Medium Schools.

(ii) Since Class-V is introduced in L.P. School- 1 G. Maths & Science Teacher, 1 English Teacher and 1 Hindi Teacher should be for imparting proper education in the L.P. School.

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Section:

As per clause -3(ii) the enrolment of a highest class of an institution is 25, but on page-15, in note (i), it is mentioned that- section would be counted on the basis of minimum enrolment of 40 students appearing in the H.S.L.C. Examination.

In this regard, we request your honor to count a section on the basis of minimum enrolment of 30 students appearing in the H.S.L.C. Examination in case of Bodo Medium.

TET Examination: You are aware that the state govt. of Assam is going to hold TET Examination for with eligibility criteria of 50% marks for General and 45% marks for S.T. Candidates and the passing mark of the same is 60% for General and 55% for S.T. Candidates.

In this regard we request your honour to take necessary arrangement to relax the illegibility criteria from 45% to 40% for S.T. as well as Bodo Medium Candidates, in respect of passing marks to relax 55% to 50% marks for S.T. as well as Bodo Medium Candidates.

That Sir, the Karbi Anglong District Bodo Sahitya Sabha is experiencing some major problems since long years in respect of educational affairs. We would like to place these grievances before your honour as mentioned below for favour of your sympathetic consideration:

(a) That in Karbi Anglong Autonomous Council, 18 Nos of schools were running as general medium schools (Assamese) till 1976 and subsequently in those institutions Bodo Medium was introduced to continue till date from 1976. But these institutions are not yet converted to Bodo Medium schools though repeated prayer was made to the authority concerned by the Karbi Anglong District Bodo Sahitya Sabha.

Therefore, your honour may be kind enough to look into this prayer and make necessary order of conversion of those schools to Bodo Medium as per the list submitted earlier.

(b) The Karbi Anglong District Bodo Sahitya Sabha considers the essence of setting up of Bodo Medium Education Cell within Karbi Anglong Autonomous Council for looking after various problems and developmental affairs of Bodo Medium Education. In this regard, the KAD-BSS has been requesting several times before the KAC Authority, but to no effect till that.

Therefore, your honor may kindly be pleased to make an order for creating the said Cell without further delay.

(c) The Nalbari L.P. School, Nalbari within Karbi Anglong Autonomous Council was set up in the year, 1993. But inspite of running so long years, this institution is not yet blessed in having permission till now from the educational authority concerned.

Therefore, your honor may kindly be pleased to make an order for giving permission without further delay.

(d) According to provision incorporated in ASSAM VENTURE EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS (Provincialisation of Services) BILL, 2011, the services of some teachers will be provincialised and some will be deprived due to non-fulfillment of required conditions. It would be injustice to the Further, it is appreciating that Karbi Anglong Autonomous Council is providing

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Financial Assistance to the teachers serving in the recognized venture M.E., High Schools and Karbi Language teachers but no such benefit is given to the Venture Bodo Medium L.P. teachers.

Therefore, your honour is earnestly prayed to continue the financial assistance till their services are provincialised with necessary arrangement for inclusion of those teachers serving in the L.P. Schools.

(e) The Govt. of Assam had declared a Special Scheme for contractual appointment of teachers of High Schools and Higher Secondary Schools in the year, 2010-2011. But it is a mater of regret that even not a single school of Karbi Anglong Autonomous Council was benefited. Under the scheme three teachers were appointed for each medium.

Therefore, your honour may kindly be pleased to make necessary arrangement to extend such benefit to the schools of Karbi Anglong Autonomous Council.

(f) There are three Blocks within Karbi Anglong Autonomous Council viz-Howraghat, Langshomepi and Samelangsho where Bodo Medium Schools are running. It is felt necessary for posting atleast one Bodo knowing S.I. of schools for each Block to look after Bodo Medium Schools.

Therefore, your honour is urged upon to make necessary arrangement for posting S.I. of Schools as requirement in the interest of Bodo Medium Education.

(G) From this Academic session of 2011-12, Bodo Elective has been introduced in the Colleges under Assam University and to impart education in this subject no sufficient Teachers are engaged by concerned G.B. of (1) Thong Nokbe College, Dokmoka (2) Rukasen College, Bokulia (3) Howraghat College, Howraghat. On the other hand though Bodo MIL has been introduced no subject Teacher has been till that.

Therefore, we request your honour to take necessary steps appointment of lecturers in Bodo and Bodo subject Teachers in the Colleges and Higher Secondary Schools mention above.

Under the fact and circumstances, the Bodo Sahitya Sabha strongly urged upon your honour to look into the above grievances for taking a positive action and for that act of your kindness the Bodo Sahitya Sabha shall remain ever grateful to you and obliged.
