Sub:- Amendment of the Assam Venture Educational Institution (Provincialization) of Services Bill, 2011.

Hon'ble Chief Minister Sir,

With humble submission an high respect the undersigned for and on behalf of the Bodo Sahitya Sabha most earnestly beg to state that the Bodo Sahitya Sabha on several occasions repeatedly and strongly place their grievances before the Education Minister of Assam and the Hon'ble Chief of the B.T.C. for the amendment of the Bill indicated above under reference. But inspite of submission of our grievances the authority concerned has not taken any positive action till now thereby wounding the sentiment of the Bodo Community and depriving the Bodo Medium Education for their adamant attitude to implement the Act without amendment as urged by the Bodo Sahitya Sabha.

In this connection the Bodo Sahitya Sabha is submitting herewith the copies of the petition submitted to the Hon'ble Education Minister of Assam, the Hon'ble Chief of the BTC and the copy of the press note of Bodo Sahitya Sabha for your kind attention and ready reference and early "Amendment of the Assam Venture Educational Institution (Provincialization) of Services Bill, 2011".

It is reiterated that on failing to take positive action the Bodo Sahitya Sabha shall be compelled to launch stern agitational programme within the premises of Jantormontor or India Gate to draw kind attention of His Excellency, the President of India, the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India and the Hon'ble Minister of Human Resource and Development.

Therefore, we earnestly request your honour for solution of the matter within the Assembly period commencing from 19th December, 2011 onwards.

Sub:- Prayer for amendment of the "Assam Venture Educational Institutions (Provincialisation) of Services Bill 2011"

Respected Sir,

The undersigned, for and on behalf of the Bodo Sahitya Sabha, have the honor to bring your kind attention on some provisions of THE ASSAM VENTURE EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS (PROVINCIALISATION OF SERVICES) BILL, 2011 and request your honor for amendment and some modifications of the provisions of the Bill which seem to be detrimental to the Bodo Medium Education in the spirit of discussion with your honour in the Dispur Secretariat Office Chamber on 22nd November, 2011 in presence of Mr. Chandan Brahma, Hon'ble Minister, Assam and Mr. Kamalsing Narzary, Hon'ble M.L.A., Bijni at 3-30 P.M.

Clause 3(1) (i):

That Sir, from 1996-2006 the then AGP Government had banned permission and recognitions of schools. But most of the Bodo Medium Schools have obtained permission and recognition from the Government after 2006. Therefore, in case of Bodo Medium Schools, the base year should be extended upto 2008.

Clause 3(1) (ii):

That Sir, in clause 3.(1),(ii), it is mentioned that there should be 25 enrolment in highest class i.e. class -V in L.P. school, class Viii in U.P. school, class -X in high school, class -Xii in Junior College or H.S.S. and Degree final year in Degree colleges. But in case of Bodo Medium there should be no such condition and enrolment bar.

Clause 3(1) (iii):

As per this clause, the pass percentage has been earmarked 30 for consecutive 3 years from 2006 to 2011, but in case of Bodo medium that should be reduced to 10%.

Clause 3(3):

As the Right to Education Act. 2009, it has been already introduced in the state, so



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the Assam Non-Government Educational Institutions (Regulation & Management) Act. 2006 to be amended and as RTE the Govt. should take necessary step of establishing new schools wherever necessary.

Clause 4(1) :

That Sir, in the matter of Educational Institutions - like venture schools , the Act speaks about the provincialisation of services and terms and conditions have been imposed 12 years for their regularization by this act. But it may be mentioned here that the venture schools have to continue the schools by arranging new teacher time to time. In this way they are compelled to fill up the gaps in time for smooth running of the school.

Therefore, we urge upon your honor to modify this provision and consider all the teachers approved by the appropriate authority till coming into force of this Act.

Clause 5(3):

This Clause seem to be injustice shown to the teachers who have rendered several years of services to the school and completed 60 years at the time on the date of coming into force of this Act.

Therefore, we urge upon your honor to modify this clause and count the service period from the date of recognition and approval of the service by the appropriate authority.

Sections 4(2) and 10(4)

We urge upon your honor to modify this clause and provide maximum number of employees per educational institution whose services shall be provincialised.

Degree College: As per clause, maximum number of posts has been shown 30 Nos.

But we would like to request your honour to increase upto 35 Nos instead of 30 posts including English & MIL.

Junior College: As per clause, maximum number of posts has been shown 8 Nos.

We would like to request your honour to increase upto 16 instead of 8 Nos (2 posts for each English & MILs).

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<u>Higher Secondary School</u>: As per clause, maximum number of posts has been shown 7 Nos.

We would like to request your honor to increase upto 12 Nos instead of 7 Nos(2 posts for each English & MILs).

<u>High & High Madrassa School (2 Classes)</u>: As per clause, only 1 Hindi teacher has been shown. But in case of mixed medium schools, it should be 2 posts.

Therefore, we would like to request your honour to increase upto 12 Nos instead of 10 Nos including 1 more post for Hindi Subject and 1 more post for language teacher in case of mixed medium schools. Because, it is seen that the Bodo Medium High Schools, language teachers have been approved by the authority concerned at the time of recognition.

Therefore, we urge upon your honor to provide Assamese Language teacher for non Assamese medium schools.

<u>Upper Primary Schools (M.E. School & M.E. Madrassa)</u>: As per clause maximum number of posts has been shown 9 in total.

We would like to request your honour to increase upto 13 Nos instead of 9 posts. Assistant Teacher: 2+2= 4 in case of mixed medium shools.

Graduate/Intermediate teacher Science & Mathematics should be 1 + 1 = 2 in case of mixed medium schools.

Hindi Teacher in the rank of Assistant Teacher should be 1 + 1 = 2 to be replaced in case of mixed medium schools.

<u>Primary School (L.P. School)</u>: (i) Head Teacher-1 and Assistant Teacher should be 2 + 2 = 5 in case of mixed medium L.P. school

(ii) Since class V is introduced in L.P. School – 1 G. Maths & Science Teacher, 1- English Teacher and 1 Hindi Teacher should be provided for imparting proper education in the L.P. school.

Section:

As per clause - 3 (ii) the enrolment of a highest class of an institution is 25, but on

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page 15, in note (i), it is mentioned that- section would be counted on the basis of minimum enrolment of 40 students appearing in the H.S.L.C. Examination.

In this regard, we request your honour to count a section on the basis of minimum enrolment of 30 students appearing in the H.S.L.C. Examination in case of Bodo Medium.
